



## **COMMITTED TO QUALITY**

#### **CLINIC'S LEGACY CONTINUES TO INSPIRE IMPROVEMENTS TO CARE**

We are excited to start new research projects here at the Clinic. Our new strategic plan recommits us to rigorous quality assurance and quality improvement research. Our legacy in this type of research set the current global standard of care and made our clinic well known in the field. Others look to us for insights into successful patient care. In support of this renewed achievements we;

- ► Had several team members attend and present at the **American Cleft Palate Craniofacial Association** meeting in May.
- ➤ Are preparing a **Legacy Collection of Records** with the American Association of Orthodontists Foundation to digitize our older facial molds and slides for greater access in future research.

▶ Are getting ready to be part of an upcoming National Institutes of Health (NIH) funded "HAPY" study that evaluates psychosocial patient outcomes in a Team care setting. This new study is an extension of the Continuity Research Network (CORNET) project.

These achievements are in addition to ongoing participation in the CORNET project and the Velopharyngeal Insufficiency Outcomes Prediction Study (VPI-OPS), both funded by NIH. Research remains core to our quality patient care commitment.
